Description: In this Proseminar we will look at Plato's and Aristotle's accounts of fallacious reasoning. Central texts will be Plato's *Euthydemus* and Aristotle's *Sophistical Refutations*. Participants will be expected to make active contributions in the form of presentations or introductions to particular themes or texts. No knowledge of Greek will be presupposed. Recommended English translations of texts by Plato and Aristotle can be found in Cooper's *Plato. Complete Works* (Hackett, 1997) and Barnes' *The Complete Works of Aristotle* (Princeton, 1984).
